STUDENT RELIGIOUS LITERATURE DISTRIBUTION

This is Attorney Timothy Denney for “Christians and the Law.” Sometimes well-meaning people describe public schools like they are a capsule totally sealed off by law from any Christian influence. This is simply not true. For example, by law students have great freedom to share their Christian faith with other students while they are at school. Students have no reason to be afraid to talk to another student about God during their free time at school. Courts have also repeatedly upheld the right of students to hand out Christian literature to other students. Schools can legally restrict when and where literature distribution takes place. The school can certainly prohibit students from handing out tracts during the math test - but outside the classroom the school cannot regulate religious literature distribution more restrictively than other types of literature. So Christian students - feel free to share your faith with other students - the law is on your side.
